4. March 25, 1953 - Cemented off perforations with 33 sacks.
5. March 29, 1953 - Tested casing - Cement job no good
6. March 29, 1953 - Re-cemented perforations 11,580-11,600 with 50 sacks
7. March 31, 1953 - Tested casing with 1000# for 30 minutes - no pressure drop
