DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

TD 11890 PB

- 3-24-53 - Squeezed off perforations in 5 1/2" casing from 9630 to 9640, with 25 Sacks of cement.
- 9597 PB - Perforated 5 1/2" casing 9480 to 9504 and 9512 to 9530 with 168 1/2" jet shots.
- 3-26-53 - Acidized w/500 gallons of mud acid - swabbed & flowed in 9 hours 62 Bbl. of load oil and 45 Bbl. of acid water.
- 3-28-53 - Acidized w/2,000 gallons of 15% low tension acid - swabbed 18 hours and recovered 36 Barrels of net oil.
- 3-30-53 - acidized with 5,000 gallons of special low tension acid - swabbed 16 hours, recovered 44 Bbl. of new oil. - shut well in and released tools. Well shut in from March 31 to April 18, moving out tools and tearing down derrick.
- 4-18-53 - Opened w/350# on tubing, flowed 59 Bbl. of oil in one hour.
- 4-23-53 - Blocked formation with 2250 gallons of Cardinal Jell Jet 99 - Acidized w/5,000 gallons of 15% Unisolv acid - swabbed 14 hours, recovered 55 Bbl. of load oil & 10 Bbl. of acid water.
- 4-25-53 - Swabbed 50 Bbl. of new oil, 4-26-53 swabbed 92 Bbl. of new oil, 4-27-53 swabbed 77 Bbl. of new oil, 4-28-53 swabbed 89 Bbl. of new oil.
