DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Ran 132 joints 4506' of 9-5/8" OD 8 RT 36# S-80 & J-55 SS Casing. Set and cemented at 4520' w/2282 sacks Lonestar Portland Bulk cement, 2157 sacks 4% gel & 125 sacks Neat on bottom. Plug at 4434'. Maximum pressure 1000#. Gulf temperature survey in 10 hours found top cement at 1435' outside 9-5/8" casing.

After waiting over 30 hours tested 9-5/8" casing w/1200# pressure for 30 minutes. There was no drop in pressure. Drilled cement plug from 4434' to 4520', tested cement below casing shoe w/500# pressure for 30 minutes. There was no drop in pressure.

After approval of Mr. Yarbrough, State Oil and Gas Inspector, preparations were made to drill ahead.
