DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

On August 3, 1953 ran 312' of 13-3/8" casing landed at 324' and cemented with 255 sacks mixed 8% gel plus 100 sacks neat cement and circulated to surface. After 36 hours WOC tested casing with 500 psi for 30 minutes with no drop in pressure. Drilled cement and shoe and tested with 500 psi for 30 minutes, and as there was no drop in pressure, drilling operations were resumed.
