jel, 200 sacks ment. Plug down at 2:30 P. M., 1-17-57. Cement did not circulate. Top of
Cement (outside of pipe) 3070'. After waiting 24 hours the casing was tested with 1000 PSI
pressure with water in the casing for 30 minutes without a loss in pressure.
