4520' - Line - Finished 11" hole to 4520' at 7:45 p.m. 4-15-53. Ran 133 jts., 8 5/8" OD 32# Casing, set at 4517' with 900 sacks regular cement mixed 4% Gel and 100 sacks neat cement, total of 1000 sacks. Plug down to 4453'. Maximum pressure 900#. Ran temperature survey, top of cement at 2482' or 40.86% fill. Tested 8 5/8" casing with 1500#, held o.k. Drilled cement inside 8 5/8" casing from 4453 to 4517', open hole from 4517 to 4520' and tested below 8 5/8" casing with 1500#, held o.k. Started drilling 7 7/8" hole at 4520' at 8:30 a.m. 4-18-53.
