12,548' Total Depth-Granite - Ran 18 Joints 18" Casing, New. Set at 12,030'. Top of liner at 11,335'. Cemented with 70 sacks Slc-Set cement. Pumped plug to 11,957' with 1200# Max. Pump Pressure. Tested 5" OD Casing with 2500# for one half hour, no pressure drop. Perforated 5" OD liner from 11,800' to 11,890' and from 11,700' to 11,780' with four jet shots per foot.
