DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

4431' - Total Depth - Line - Finished drilling 12-1/4" hole at 3:00 P.M. 12-1-52. Ran a total of 114 joints of 9-5/8" OD 36# Casing, set at 4426' with 1800 sacks cement with 3% Gel. Plug pumped to 4336' at 8:45 P.M. 12-2-52. Maximum pressure 800#. Ran Temperature survey, found top of cement outside 9-5/8" casing at 2907', or, 51.9% fill. After W.O.C. for 24 hours, tested 9-5/8" casing for 1/2 hour with 1800#, no pressure drop. Drilled cement from 4336' to 4431' and tested casing for 1/2 hour with 1000# - no pressure drop. Started drilling formation and 8-5/4" hole at 10:15 A.M. 12-4-52.
