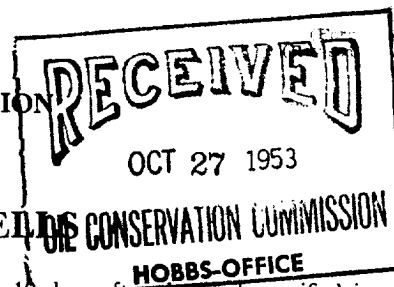

DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

13 1/8" casing was set at a depth of 346' and cemented with 375 sac cement. Cementing was done by the pump and plug method. The annular space behind the casing was completely filled with cement from the shoe to the bottom of the collar. The cement was allowed to stand for 48 hours before drilling plug.
