Detailed account of work done, nature and quantity of materials used and results obtained.

Spudded May 22, 1959. Drilled 17 1/2 inch hole to 426 feet. Bottomed in blue shale. Ran and set 13 3/8 inch O. D. new, grade H-40, 48#, seamless surface pipe at 418.50 feet. Cemented with 500 sacks of Lone Star Incore Neat cement. Circulated approximately 200 sacks back to surface. Tested surface May 24, 1959, with 1000# water pressure for 30 minutes. Pressure loss was 15# caused by a small leak in blow out preventer ram - okay.
