Gentlemen:

To bring you up to date on the Humble State #1 well, located 660 feet from the south and east lines of Section 27, T-12-S, R-31-E, 1924, Lea County, New Mexico, we are enclosing copy of Notice of Intention to Drill, Well location and acreage dedication plat and copy of Miscellaneous Notice dated March 13, 1959. Rig moved on location Friday, March 6, 1959, and drilling of said well commenced at 6:30 p.m., Mountain Standard Time, March 9, 1959.

3-10-59	Set 13-5/8" at 362 feet with 350 sacks cement. Plug down at 11:15 a.m. (Mountain Standard Time)
3-11-59	Waiting on Cement. Will drill out at 11:15 a.m.
3-12-59	Drilling at 1480 feet in Red Bed
3-13-59	Drilling at 2000 feet in Anhydrite
3-16-59	Drilling at 3687' Anhydrite
3-17-59	Fishing at 3698 feet, Anhydrite & Gyp. Stuck below big pipe.
3-18-59	Fishing
3-19-59	Still fishing. Bit stuck at 1755'.
3-20-59	Still fishing. Backed off of fish, in process of washing over it to get it. Drill collar in hole.
3-23-59	Still fishing
3-24-59	"
3-25-59	Drill collar out of hole & now trying to get out one cone that is left. Should be back drilling this afternoon.
3-26-59	Drilling at 3849 feet in Anhydrite
3-27-59	Good Friday, no report. Elevation 4166 feet up.
3-30-59	Set 8-5/8" at 4244 feet with 550 bbls. Ken-Tex, 10 bbls. Line Water, 200 sacks cement. WOC
