- DST#1: 9780'-9870' (90' Bough "A"). Tool open 2 hrs 19 minutes thru 5/8" BC 1/2" TC, 4" DP. Opened w/strong blow. GTS 7 minutes. MTS 62 minutes. OTS 87 minutes. Cleaned to pits 9 minutes. Flowed approximately 3 BO. Turned thru separator. Flowed 20 BO in 40 minutes thru 1/2" choke. FSP 120 psi. Oil Gravity 47.5° API. Reversed out 27 BO. Recovered 113' GCM below circulating sub. Total recovery 50 BO. BHT 153°F. 90 minutes ISIBHP 3046 psi. FBHP 755-1344 psi. 72 minutes FSIBHP 2227 psi. HMP 5018. Recovered mud titrated 40,000 ppm Cl⁻. Pit mud titrated 53,000 ppm Cl⁻. Positive Test. (Johnston)
- DST#2: 10,127'-10,243' Straddle Test. (116' Bough G & H Limestone). Tool open 1 hour 56 minutes, including 4 minutes preflow, thru 5/8" BC, 1/2" TC & 4" DP. Opened w/strong blow. GTS 17 minutes increased to 260 MCFPD. Surface pressure 25 psi. Flared all gas to pits. Reversed out estimated 30 BO cut 4% BS&W. Recovered 85' gas & mud, cut oil below circulating sub, cut 47% oil & 14% BS (mud), 39% water. Water titrated 16,800 ppm Cl⁻. Pit mud titrated 80,000 ppm Cl⁻. 90 minutes ISIBHP 3508 psi. FBHP 283-994 psi. 120 minutes FSIBHP 2716 psi. HMP 5341-5351 psi. Positive Test. (Johnston)
