This is to advise that the captioned well is an unorthodox location in the Ranger Lake-Bough Pool by virtue of being located in the NE/4 of the NW/4 of the section. Field Rule No. 4, as adopted in NMOC Case No. 4421, Order No. R-4031, provides that the first well on a proration unit shall be located in either the NW/4 or SE/4 of the quarter section on which the well is located. The completion of this well in this pool was the subject of Case No. 4421.
