July 23, 1968 Pumping equipment installed. Pumped well until March, 1969.

March 1, 1968 Shut well in due to lack of capacity to dispose of produced water.

This well was produced by pump from July, 1968 to March, 1969. The best production during this period was 30 BOPD and 340 barrels of water.

The disposal well in this field does not have the capacity to take all of the water produced from the wells connected to our North Morton disposal system. This well and the Tenneco Federal have been shut in pending satisfactory disposition of produced water.
