Nov. 1, 1967 Temporarily abandoned.
July 23, 1968 Hydraulic (Kobe) pumping equipment installed to pump test - started pumping 2:00 p.m. Pump water and oil emulsion - making some gas.
July 24, 1968 Pull pump.
July 31, 1968 Start back to pumping.
Aug. 1, 1968 Pumping 27 BWPD - making gas to run engine.
Aug. 3, 1968 Estimated 2 to 3 barrels oil and 395 barrels water in 24 hrs.
Aug., 1968 Production - small amount of oil and 400 BWPD.
Sept., 1968 Cleaned up well - 500 gallons BDA acid.
Sept. 11, 1968 Working on well. Production swabbed and pumped water, traces oil.
Oct., 1968 On October 3 - well began to make a little oil. Production - 390 to 340 BWPD and occasional small amounts of oil. Last days of month oil increasing, water decreasing.
Nov., 1968 Oil production 20 to 25 BOPD - water production dropped from 340 to 280 - 290 BWPD.
Well makes enough gas to run engine. Will complete well as a producer.
First oil sold November 22, 1968.
