February flowed 2369 barrels of oil.

March, April and to May 15th flowed 410 barrels of oil. Water continued
to increase.

May 1968 - installed hydraulic pumping equipment.

June 1968 - pumped 3494 barrels of oil. Production of oil dropped
steadily and water increased until the well was shut in on
March 12, 1969. On the shut in date, the well was producing
1200 barrels of water and 30 barrels of oil per day.*****
Our salt water disposal well does not have the capacity to take all of
the water from wells connected to the disposal system. Therefore, this
well and the Anderson Fee well have been shut in until an arrangement
can be made for additional disposal capacity.
