

Gentlemen:

The Superior Oil Company respectfully requests permission to commingle in common storage oil produced from the dually completed (Lower Wolfcamp and Upper Penn) State "L" #1.

The attached plat shows location of the well and tank battery.

Legal description of the tract involved is as follows: SE/4 Section 33, T-13-S, R-34-E. This includes only a portion of State Lease OG-5217.

Commingle of the two crudes will not result in a change of value. The Upper Penn crude has an API gravity of 43.2°, the Lower Wolfcamp 44.5°. All crude with 46° API gravity or above is currently listed at \$3.16 per barrel.

A schematic diagram of the system is attached. All lines will be installed above ground. Both zones are physically incapable of producing top unit allowable for their respective pools. The proposed installation conforms to the requirements of the Oil Conservation Commission as outlined in the Manual For The Installation and Operation of Commingle Facilities, September 13, 1961.

Enclosed is a check in the amount of \$10.00 for the filing fee.


