Gentlemen:

We are in the process of attempting to clear up all of the unreleased plugged wells in our district and find that the above well is still carried under your company in our files. In 1979 we received a request for a change of operator from Roberts & Hammack to Vista Resources, Inc. but we were unable to approve this change because they did not have an approved plugging bond. Vista Resources was advised we would be unable to approve the change of operator until they had an approved plugging bond on file with our Santa Fe office. No bond was ever obtained by Vista Resources Inc.

In view of the above, you are the last operator of record and are still liable for cleanup of the location. Our recent inspection indicates the well has been plugged; however, the following surface cleanup needs to be completed before it can be released.

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In view of the above, you are the last operator of record and are still liable for cleanup of the location. Our recent inspection indicates the well has been plugged; however, the following surface cleanup needs to be completed before it can be released.

- 1) Pits levelled
- 2) Anchors cut
- 3) Cellar filled

We regret that we have let this matter go unresolved for such a long period of time. However, if you would see that the above three things are taken care of we will be able to release this location. When the cleanup has been completed, please sign and return a copy of this letter and we will recheck the location for release.
