17. Describe Proposed or Completed Operations (Clearly state all pertinent details, and give pertinent dates, including estimated date of starting any proposed work) SEE RULE 1103.

The above captioned well was completed April 4, 1971, pumping 77 BOPD plus 19 BWPD. A GOR Test of May 19, 1971, this well tested 15 BOPD plus 8 BWPD and similar test of September 12, 1971, tested 14 BOPD plus 5 BWPD. This well was worked over and re-treated with 1500 gals acid in November 6, 1971 and failed to respond to acid treatment and was considered unprofitable to operate. Last production was February 1972 prior to removing pumping equipment and tank battery from lease. This well is currently shut in with tubing and well head in place.

We request this well be carried in temporary abandoned status until additional drilling is completed in immediate area or a means of disposal for the State "H" well is determined.
