17. Describe Proposed or Completed Operations (Clearly state all pertinent details, and give pertinent dates, including estimated date of starting any proposed work) SEE RULE 1103.

A spudder rig was moved on the above location on February 19, 1971 and drilled a 15" hole to total depth of 198'. This rig operated on a 24 hour basis; however, due to rig repairs, caving hole conditions, and weather conditions, drilling progressed at a slow rate. On April 19, 1971, after 60 days of operations, hole had caved and cleanout depth was 163'. Rig was released.

On May 4th, 1971 The Superior Oil Company transferred ownership of this well to Mr. W. A. Anderson who has the surface rights on this lease, for use as a water well.

On May 6th, 1971 10' of 13-3/8" casing was set at surface and cemented with approximately one yard of concrete. Location is cleaned and leveled.
