There was apparently some misunderstanding regarding the verbal instructions I gave for plugging the subject well, and the 100' plug required to be set at the top of the salt was omitted. Since this is one of the more important plugs, and the only one set between the salt and the fresh water, I feel that it is imperative that the well be re-entered and the plug set. This should not entail a great deal of additional work.

Please advise as to your intent in this regard.
