Coastal Oil & Gas Corporation wishes to make public its request for administrative approval of an application for authorization to inject water into the Devonian formation in a well located 990' FSL and 1980' FWL Section 34, T-13-S, R-33-E. The proposed zone for injection is from approximately 13,500' to 13,700'. The purpose of this well is to dispose of produced water from the Baum (Penn) Field wells operated by Coastal Oil & Gas Corporation and its partners. The anticipated maximum injection rate is 2300 BWPD and maximum anticipated surface injection pressure is 2000 psi.
