Detailed account of work done, nature and quantity of materials used and results obtained.

Subject well was prepared for temporary abandonment October 26, 1956, after having been drilled with cable-tools to a depth of 45 feet. No zone productive of oil, gas, or water had been penetrated, and no casing had been set in the hole. Well was filled to within 9 feet of the surface with drilling mud. A 7 foot cement plug was run to bottom of 2 foot deep cellar. A substantial wooden cover was placed over the hole at the bottom of the cellar, and then the cellar was filled to ground level with dirt. Working pit has been filled and location cleared of junk.
