**NOTICE OF INTENTION TO ABANDON WELL**

Notice must be given at least five days before work is to begin to the State Geologist or to the proper Oil and Gas Inspector. It is desirable that a representative of the Department of the State Geologist witness the plugging of wells being abandoned whenever possible. If changes in the proposed plan are considered advisable, a copy of this notice showing such changes will be returned to the sender. Submit this notice in duplicate.

Dear Sir:

You are hereby notified that it is our intention to abandon and plug Well  
No. 1 in SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Sec. 18 Twp. 12, Rge. 35,  
N. M. P. M., Lea Oil Field, Lea County.  
We plan to commence work on plugging immediately, 1932.

The reasons for wishing to abandon the well are as follows:

Dry hole.

The present condition of the well is as follows:

4 Strings of casing in the well consisting of  
15 $\frac{1}{2}$ ", 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ ", 10 and 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ ".

Note: This well was carried as the Holmes and Huey well #1. The first well or hole was lost and the rig was skidded, but it was still carried as #1. Form SG101 calls it #2 but every other report calls it #1.

The work which we propose to do in abandoning the well is as follows:

Pull casing. Fill with mud to 145', set cement  
plug and fill with mud to top.
