Gentlemen:

Please refer to your letter of May 1, 1961 concerning a request for 80 acre spacing on your Campana No. 1 Federal "C" located in Section 10, T-7-S, R-32-E.

The Commission Rules and Regulations dictate a spacing of 40 acres for oil wells and any deviation from this has resulted from a Hearing in which special pool rules were established. Consequently, if you desire 80 acre spacing for this well and any subsequent wells that might be drilled in this pool it will be necessary that you apply for a Hearing to create special pool rules for this area.

Your allowable request will be processed for this well and a 40 acre allowable will be assigned. Since only 40 acres can be assigned this well, it will be necessary that you file a corrected Form C-128 designating the 40 acres to be dedicated. We will also appreciate your furnishing us with a copy of the form submitted to the U. S. G. S. which outlines the work done on the well.
