DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

10,295' Total Depth. Line Ran Schlumberger surveys. Drill stem test of section 10,215' to 10,295' - no show oil or gas - recovered 720' of salt water.

To abandon well following cement plugs were run:

A 35 sx cement plug from 10,086' to 10,200'

A 35 sx cement plug from 9038' to 9250'

A 35 sx cement plug from 3317' to 3430'

and a 10 sx cement plug in top of 13-3/8" OD casing and 8-5/8" OD casing.

No attempt made to salvage 8-5/8" OD casing as cement had circulated to a point 28' from surface. Hole was filled with heavy drilling mud between all cement plugs.

A piece of 4-inch line pipe cemented in top of 13-3/8" OD casing and extends five feet above ground level to serve as abandoned well marker.
