DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

A 50' cement plug was placed in 9-5/8" casing and open hole below from 3290-3230' on August 9, 1952 by Cactus Drilling Company rig. After the rig was moved off, Hobbs Pipe and Supply Company moved in. 9-5/8" casing was cut at 791' and pulled out of hole. A 25 sack plug was spotted in top of 9-5/8" stub; a 25 sack plug placed in bottom of 13-3/8" casing and a 5 sack plug placed in top of 13-3/8" casing with iron marker extending 4 feet above ground level. Hole is completely filled with 9.5#/gallon mud.
