FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK

FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

On August 8, 1952, our A. A. Sadler #1 Well, reached total depth of 8154 in granite. We plan on setting 50' cement plug from 3290 to 3230; cut and pull approximately 1000' of 9-5/8" casing; set 50' cement plug from 1020' to 970'; set cement plug from 250' to 300'; place cement plug in top of 13-3/8" casing with iron marker extending 4 feet above surface of ground. We will leave hole full of 9.5#/gallon mud. Later we will fill pits and clear location.
