FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK

FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

As of 7:00 AM, May 26, 1952, this well was drilling at 2110'. From samples it appears anhydrite top to be at about 1700'. We are drilling a 12-1/4" hole, plan on drilling to 3200' and set 9-5/8" casing at this approximate depth. We will use sufficient cement to place top of cement in annular space between casing and hole at about 1500', or well above anhydrite. After waiting on cement to set for 24 hours, we plan to test casing by building up a pressure of 1000 Psi, closing valve and allowing to stand for 30 minutes. If pressure does not drop more than 100 Psi, we plan on drilling plug and drilling ahead to total depth.
