DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

The well was spudded on May 21 and drilled to total depth of 286', or 70' below the top of red bed. 13-3/8" casing was set at 286' and cemented with 275 sacks of 3% gel Howco cement. Cement was circulated to surface. After allowing 24 hours for cement to set and before drilling plug, a pressure of 1000 Psi was built up on casing. Valve was closed and pressure allowed to stand for 30 minutes. There was no noticeable drop in pressure. Test was O.K.
