FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK

FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

Drilling to commence on A. A. Sadler #1 before Friday, May 23rd. We plan to drill a 17-1/2" hole to a depth of 350', set 13-3/8" casing, and cement with 275 sacks of neat cement, 3% gel. We will have a 13-3/8" Float shoe on bottom of casing. After cement has set for 24 hours, we then plan to test casing by building up a pressure of 1000 Psi, closing valve and allowing to stand for 30 minutes. If pressure does not drop more than 100 Psi, we plan on drilling plug and drilling ahead to next casing depth of 3200'. You will be notified by phone prior to test.
