DEPICTED FIELD NOTES

STATE of NEW MEXICO
County of Roosevelt

S.E. 1/4 Sec. No. 36,
Township No. 2- S. (Oil Well Location.)
Range No. 31- E., NMRM.

The subtending sketch truly depicts a survey which I did on the ground for the purpose of locating the center of the S.E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of the S.E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of section No. 36, township No. 2 S., in range No. 31 E., N.M.P.

This survey truly conforms with the original survey and is fully in harmony with the improvements as on the ground at date of this survey.

Said center location is marked with a white painted 2"x8" pine stake, and is 660ft. W. and 660ft. N. of the S.E. corner of said section No. 36.

Survey order also called for the elevation at said center which is 4440.12ft. above sea level. Several elevations made in this vicinity, by this surveyor have never been checked for closure on a circuit but very careful having been done I am sure the results are close. I am showing several other locations in this plat that a check may be made if desired.
