Set surface pipe 284 feet, approximately 250 sacks of cement, circulated set up 24 hours. Drilling began November 22, 1956 and continued through this date November 29, 1956 through various sands mostly red shale now drilling at 3,420 feet in Greyburg

Surface pipe was tested under 900 pounds of pressure for approximately thirty minutes and test was found to be satisfactory.
