Dear Sir:

We have received the captioned bond to cover a new operation of yours to be known as Taylor No. 5. We do not have the exact surveyed location and ask that this be furnished by a registered land surveyor before the Commission is able to take any steps.

When we have received the surveyor's plat showing location of this intended operation, we shall let you hear from us further.

There have been five wells to date drilled on this 40-acre tract, and wells known as No. 1 and No. 1-A have not been definitely plugged to the satisfaction of the Commission. When the full details of plugging have been submitted to Mr. Yarbrough with your notarized signature and he approves, then the Commission will have the authority to cancel two of your outstanding bonds.

In order to keep the record straight, we would appreciate your giving us a detailed statement showing exact footage of each of the five wells already drilled by you, the total depth, and your present intentions.
