Dear Roy:

In connection with my letter dated January 25th., regarding clearance by the commission re-the well located in the NW corner of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 22, Bond SY-137522, dated 12/10/45, also well located 200 feet SW, of the center of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 22, both located in T. 2S, R. 30E, Roosevelt, County, New Mexico. The last well bond was issued on 4/10/46, No. Bond SY-140007, this well was plugged and approved as of June 25th, 1948.

It would therefore appear that the only bond as yet outstanding covers the last well No. 4, located in the SE corner of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 22, said Bond having been approved by the Commission as of the 25th of June 1948. And as I have not to date made any definite plan as to the well, said well is still not in a state of completion.

I am in receipt of a letter from Mr. Echlin, of El Paso, Texas, Agent for the American Employers Ins Co, re-the above dated February 22nd. Requesting that I have the above matters meet the approval of the Commission. So that we may close the bond obligation.

I, fully appreciate how busy you are. However I would deeply appreciate your early cooperation to this matter.
