Dear Mr.Sweeney:

I have yours dated June 25th., re-unplugged shallow well about 150 feet east of Taylor No.3.

This is a water well drilled to a depth of 165 feet. With water sand from 155-165 feet. Fluid level while low at around 130 feet below surface. Pumps at the rate of 3 gallons per minute. This well has, and is the source of our drilling water supply.

We have been producing this water through 2 inch tubing, and if the current well fails to produce oil in commercial amounts. Shall offer the landowner Mr.Frank Taylor the right to take over the water well, or I shall plug same to the satisfaction of the Commission.

Sorry I failed to mention this well to you on your visit here.
