## DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

On May 23rd., completed running 1425' 8 inch casing to bottom. Picked pipe up, and Halliburton pumped 125 sacks cement behind pipe, leaving a 22 foot plug in pipe. Let cement set until noon May 27th., Drilled solid cement for 22' to shoe. Gave shut off 1000# pressure test on casing. Pressure held up. Drilling ahead as of today at 1545'.
