FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK

FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION
FIRST NATIONAL BANK, Brownfield, Texas, held chattel mortgage on pipe and rig. Same foreclosed by suit Dist. Court, Roosevelt County, N.M. Sold by Sheriff of Roosevelt County, N.M. and bought in by Bank. First National Bank, Brownfield, Texas, had Mr. Roy McCoy, Geologist of Lubbock, Texas, pull pipe (306 feet of 13" O.D. and 700 feet of 10-3/4" O.D.) No water below 240 feet (underground river 190' to 240'). Pulled 10-3/4" string & filled with mud. Set bridge and cemented 250-306'; Pulled 13" and left as water well for Mr. M. G. Vinther, the land owner, at his request.

(The suit was brought against me, individually, and styled FIRST NATIONAL BANK, Brownfield, Texas vs R. P. Lynn and was handled by Mears & Mears, Attorneys, of Portales, N.M.)
