Dear Sir:

With reference to your letters and my telephone call to your Assistant Miss S. J. Smith, we are enclosing Forms C-102, C-103 and C-105. As you will recall in our telephone conversation, we explained that we did not have any logs or drilling records on this well and that we hired the Skaggs Drilling Company, who is a reliable company, to clean out and plug the well at the bottom of the casing. According to the information we have been able to get, the well has been properly cemented and after it was plugged it was closely observed for several days and no water was passing the plug and we assume that the plugging was satisfactory.

Mr. F. N. Vinther, the present owner of the land, did not want the well filled and plugged at the surface and has signed a notarized statement accepting the responsibility of the well and that the plugging was satisfactory to him. We are attaching his statement to the above-mentioned forms enclosed herewith.
