DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

A 17" hole was spudded with portable unit on November 21, 1953 to depth of 30 feet. Rotary rig was moved in and drilling resumed on November 23, 1953. A total depth of 260' was reached at 1:30 P.M., November 24, 1953 and 13-3/8" Spiral Weld 29.3# casing was run to total depth and cemented with 275 sacks at 8:00 P.M. November 24, 1953. Cement circulated back to surface. 247' of casing left in hole.

Allowed cement 36 hours set time then tested casing before drilling plug.
Cement job tested O.K.
