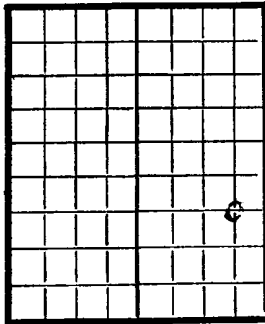

You are hereby notified that it is our intention to commence the drilling of a well to be known as Spartan Drilling Company State 1-36 well No. 1 in NE 1/4 of SE 1/4 of Sec. 36, T. 43, R. 32 E, N. M., P. M., Wildcat Field, Roosevelt County. The well is 1980 feet (N.) (S.) of the 3. line and 660 feet (E.) (W.) of the East line of Section 36-43-31E

The subtending sketch truly depicts a survey which I did on the ground, according to law, for the purpose of locating a prospective oil well in the center of the N.E.  $\frac{1}{4}$  of the S.E.  $\frac{1}{4}$  of section No. 36, township No. 4 S., range No. 31 E. NMPM.

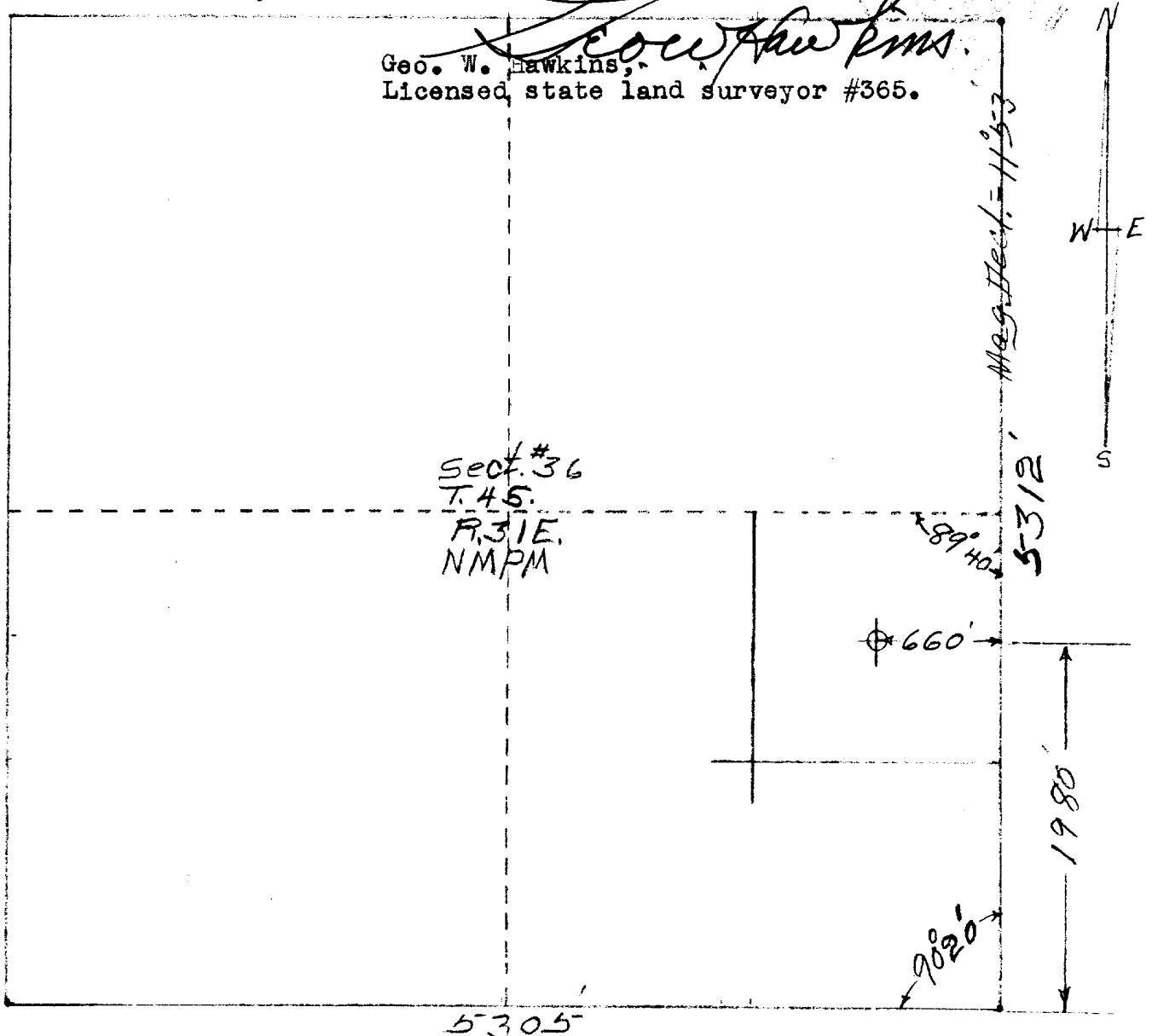
In this survey I began at the S.W. corner of said section No. 36 which is a point in the center line of a public road running N. & S. and forming a T which runs E. along the S. side of this section; thence E. 5305ft. to the S.E. corner of this section, a point in the center line of public road 30ft. S. of old fence corner; thence turning an angle of  $90^{\circ}20'$  interior to the S.E. corner of this section go N. along the fourth guide meridian east, which is defined on the ground by an old boisdarc and cedar post fence, at 5312ft. find old boisdarc fence corner which is the N.E. corner of this section No. 36.

Since old improvements harmonize with my findings, as described above, and knowing that the excesses found are similar to excesses thruought this vicinity, i did not make farther invistigations.

Note, that the oil well location does not include excess in either dimention.
