FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK

FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

This well is presently at a total depth of 7265' in granite. Granite wash was topped at 7100'. It appears that this well is a dry hole as no oil or gas zones have been penetrated since setting the salt string (9-5/8" casing) at 2499'. We are submitting the following plugging and abandonment program:

Lay a 100' cement plug from 4950'-5050'

Shoot off, pull 700' of 9-5/8" casing

Lay a 50' cement plug in open hole from 500'-550'

Lay a 25' cement plug at the surface in the 13-3/8" casing with a 4" marker extending 4' above mean ground level.
