17. Describe Proposed or Completed Operations (Clearly state all pertinent details, and give pertinent dates, including estimated date of starting any proposed work) SEE RULE 1103.

Permission to plug and abandon and approval of plugging program were received verbally on April 24, 1967, from the District I Office. All plugging was performed on April 26, 1967. Set regular neat cement plugs as follows: 3910' to 3810' (100') with 30 sacks, 3125' to 3075' (50') with 25 sacks, 2050' to 2000' (50') with 25 sacks, 1850' to 1800' (50') with 25 sacks, 410' to 360' (50') with 25 sacks and surface to 20' below ground level with 10 sacks.

The 7-7/8" open hole drilled to 4150' total depth was reamed to 9-7/8" from 387' to 3210' prior to start of plugging operations. At time of plugging, hole was loaded with mud having a weight of 10.4 lbs. per gal. Plugs were spotted through 4-1/2" O.D. drill pipe. A steel marker was set at the surface.

All of the 10-3/4" O.D. surface casing set at 384' was left in the hole; no other casing strings were run.
