Gentlemen:

A recent surface inspection on six of your plugged and abandoned wells in the Chaveroo Pool, Roosevelt County, New Mexico, found all six well locations in good shape, but the old battery locations were in bad shape. We will have to hold the bonds on two wells until the battery area is cleaned up.

H.S.G. battery area in Unit I, Section 26, T7S, R32E

- (1) Battery pad needs levelling
- (2) Pit needs covering and levelling
- (3) Line pipe needs removing
- (4) Junk and fencing needs removing

Atlantic Tucker battery area in Unit N, Section 24, T7S, R32E

- (1) Battery pad needs levelling
- (2) Pit needs covering and levelling
- (3) Line pipe needs removing
- (4) Fencing and junk needs removing

We will hold the H.S.G. #2 well and the Atlantic Tucker #1 well until the above work is completed. The Commission feels that 2 years is more than ample time to get these locations in shape, so please do the work needed as soon as possible and notify us when completed and we will reinspect these locations.

Also, we do not have the final plugging C-103 reports on any of the six wells listed below. Please submit as soon as possible.

- H.S.G. #4, Unit O, Section 26, T7S, R32E
- H.S.G. #1, Unit P, Section 26, T7S, R32E
- Anderson State #6, Unit L, Section 36, T7S, R32E
- Atlantic Tucker #1, Unit N, Section 24, T7S, R32E
- Atlantic Tucker #2, Unit M, Section 24, T7S, R32E.
