SUBJECT: Change in Pool Designation Harris 14 Well #1-B in 14-6-33 (Roosevelt County, NM) Federal 14 Well #1-K in 14-6-33 (Roosevelt County, NM)

According to the provisions of Division Order R-6967, effective May 1, 1982, the Tanneyhill Pennsylvanian Gas Pool was abolished.

Your Harris 14 #1-B and your Federal 14 #1-K are currently carried as Tanneyhill Penn Gas wells. Your <u>Harris 14 #1</u> has been re-evaluated and the correct producing formation has been determined to be Granite Wash instead of Penn and the well will be placed in the newly created <u>SOUTH TANNEYHILL-GRANITE WASH GAS POOL</u>. Your <u>Federal 14 #1</u>, which does produce from the Penn formation, will be placed in the <u>SOUTH</u> <u>PETERSON PENNSYLVANIAN ASSOCIATED POOL</u>.

Please amend your records to show this change in pool designation.
