Gentlemen:

By this letter, BHP Petroleum (Americas) Inc. requests that the above referenced well be granted administrative approval for an unorthodox location and a non-standard (160 acre) proration unit. Also, BHP requests that this acreage be simultaneously assigned to the Bledsoe #1 so that this well may continue to produce until dead. Current rate from the Bledsoe #1 is only 7 MCFPD and this well will be plugged as soon as it stops producing altogether.
