Thank you very much for your telephone call just now regarding the Packer Leakage Test.

Our Speight #1 was a dual producing well - - and when we temporarily abandoned the Tule-Montoya portion of that well, as per our letter of January 7th, 1991 - - your reply dated January 10th, 1991, executed by Jerry Sexton, advised "the above-referenced well is exempt from packer leakage test until such time as the downhole conditions are changed".

We enclose copies of these letters for your review.

We want to do everything you request us to do - - however we wanted to make sure - - as we always set up the Packer Leakage Test in advance with John West Engineering Company - - and as the Speight dual well and the McGee dual well are similar we wanted your ruling on the Packer Leakage Test.
