DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Drilled well to 4144', ran 112 joints, 4140', of 8-5/8" OD 32# casing set at 4142'. Cemented with 2475 sacks 3% gel and 100 sacks 3% gel cement. Pumped plug to 4114'. Cement circulated to surface. Tested casing with 1000# before and after drilling plug. No pressure loss.
