
The recompletion C-104 on your New Mexico AS State #1 has been received and our geologist has compared your perforated interval with the log on this well. He picks the top of the Wolfcamp at 8840 feet. In view of this, your perforations 8870-8910 feet will be Wolfcamp instead of Abo. There will be no need for a recompletion C-104. However, you will need to submit a C-103 covering the work done including the perforations.

I believe you may have been considering making an application to down-hole commingle the Wolfcamp and your proposed Abo completion. However, in light of the above, you will be able to produce the perforated interval 9226-9307 with the new perforated interval 8870-8910' without securing authority to downhole commingle.
