Ran and cemented 19 joints and 1 pc. (568.10') 13-3/8" O.D., 48#, J-55, new snls. casing at 605.15' with 700 sq. 4% gel cement with 2% calcium chloride. Cement circulated. Cement in place 2:45 p.m., February 1, 1961.

Waited on cement 18 hours. Released pressure, nipple up and tested casing with 1000# for 30 minutes. O.K.

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
